Team Structure:

3 players

- At least one Kyu grade (Kyu will always play first)
- Only one 3rd Dan or above (Can have more than one dan player)
- Team members do not need to be members of the same club

Competition Structure: Round 1 will include Pools, ensuring all players will play at least two matches. Each match will be limited to 3 minutes, except the final, which will be limited to 5 minutes.

How To Enter: Please enter via your club secretary. For teams made up of players from different clubs, the team captain should enter the full team via their club, including payment. Entry closes Friday 18th Feb. No late entries will be accepted. You must be an AKR member to enter.
